

**RECOMMENDATIONS FOR STUDENTS OF VETERINARY  
IN CONNECTION WITH PARTICIPATION IN LABORATORY AND CLINICAL CLASSES**

1. Only a healthy person may participate in the classes. They cannot be attended by students who:
    - A. have disease symptoms characteristic of COVID-19 (cough, runny nose, shortness of breath, muscle pain),
    - B. they are at home with a person undergoing quarantine or isolation at home
    - C. either they are quarantined or placed in isolation at home.
- The student's absence from classes should be excused in accordance with the Regulations of the University of Life Sciences.
2. You should limit the things you take with you to classes (backpacks, mobile phones, tablets, wallets, etc.). Unnecessary personal belongings should be left before the classes in a designated place.
  3. Before entering the building, each student undergoes a body temperature measurement made by an employee of the unit conducting the classes.
  4. At the beginning of the class, each student completes a qualification questionnaire.
  5. Each Student uses his /her own, if possible, accessories necessary for the efficient and effective implementation of classes.
  6. You cannot borrow any items from other participants.
  7. Students may leave the building where the classes are held or stay in the building during the break, if there is adequate space to keep the social distance defined by law, at least 2 meters from the other person (**do not group**) .

Principles of individual protection :

1. Only students with mouth and nose protectors (disposable or reusable masks, visors for people who cannot cover their mouth and nose with a mask for health reasons) may enter the classes.
2. The principle of covering the mouth and nose is valid throughout the premises where the classes are held. If for any reason the nose and mouth protection has to be removed, an absolute 2-meter distance to other people must be observed. During classes, there must be at least 2 meters distance between Students in each direction.
3. Students arrive at the classes no later than 10-15 minutes in advance, allowing the temperature at the entrance to the building to be measured by an employee of the unit conducting the classes, placing personal belongings in a designated room, putting on protective clothing, washing hands in accordance with the rules of using the toilets, temperature measurement and hand disinfection.
4. Students leave unnecessary personal belongings before entering classes - backpack, bag, jacket, mobile phone, etc. - in a place where e.g. plastic bags for packing them will be prepared. Students leaving or picking up their belongings are obliged to maintain appropriate security measures (distance from other people, covering mouth and nose).
5. Gatherings of Students should be avoided before, during and after the class. While waiting for the entrance to the classes, students should keep a distance of at least 2 meters and keep their mouth and nose covered.
6. Before entering the classroom where the classes are held, Students should wash their hands thoroughly with soap and water, disinfect them obligatorily, and then put on gloves (the University will provide disinfection and gloves). Gloves are removed after the end of the classes.
7. During the laboratory classes, students work at the workplace and do not move (unless required by the experiments or indicated by the teacher).
8. In case of any symptoms of malaise, the student is obliged to immediately inform the teacher about it.
9. It is recommended to pay attention not to touch the skin of the face, lips, nasal mucosa, conjunctiva.
10. It is recommended to care for personal hygiene, frequent hand washing with disinfectants.
11. It is recommended to change protective clothing (if possible) before each subsequent class.
